SIX project space - a brief overview

Year one

- We had a white cube gallery space in Boscombe that provided constant exhibition space for local and national artists.
- Arranged artists talks
- Led crits for around four/five artists at a time to share and discuss their work.
- Facilitated a Big Draw event for the local community.
- Supported both staff and students from Arts University Bournemouth with exhibition opportunities.
- Hosted three book launches.
- Made the space available for a couple of music related events.
- Made the space available for the local community to rent.



Year two

- Created an online film (Vimeo) channel and currently have made nine films and have two more waiting to edit, and two more artists lined up to film.
- Organised and supported five exhibitions.
- Made links with Bank Street Arts Sheffield and supported them through making four films (so far) about artists from their community.
- Involved with BEAF (Bournemouth Emerging Arts Fringe) 2015.
- Facilitated one leg of this summers Tanteo project that saw us hosting ten international artists within our community.
- Facilitating collaborations and networking locally and nationally.

 Working with local council to create an exhibition and book documenting the history of Rastgarth house and Arthur & Nancy Bell who lived there.



Year Three - and beyond

- Move the SIX house to Sheffield.
- Leave a core team of SIX in Bournemouth to facilitate projects.
- Continue with making artists films.
- Offer month long residencies for exploration of work.
- Create more links across cities beginning with Sheffield and Bournemouth and expanding to more as we move forward.
- Host retreats for in depth discussion between groups of artists.
- Investigate publishing books.

We have had 34 exhibitions, worked with around 130 artists, have nearly 1000 followers on facebook and 500 people on our mailing list.
